

Step-by-step guide to get your exit-entry record

You can use the National Immigration Administration (NIA) mini program through WeChat, Alipay, or NIA platform to enquire and download your latest exit-entry record.

Please note that HSBC only accept the latest record (this should be the same date as your account application date), you may follow the below instruction example of using NIA mini program on WeChat to get your record, store it at your device and upload it.

Step 1 – Open NIA mini program Search "移民局12367" to locate the mini program. Step 2 - Select "中国公民服务"

Step 3 - Select "出入境记录查询"







Step 4 – Log on Select your ID type, input your full name and ID number to log on.

Step 5 – Facial recognition For first-time users, complete the facial recognition steps to continue.






Step 6 – Select enquiry period Please note that we only accept the latest record (this should be the same date as your account application date).


You can specify the range or select the period you want.



Step 7 - Select "查詢" to proceed with the next step

Step 8 - Select "文件预览"





Upon opening the file, select the "..." button from the top right corner and select "用其他应用打开".

For Android users, you may save the document to your device directly.








Step 10 – Store the file

Select "存储到文件" to save the file to your device, you will see the document is saved after that.

Upload your exitentry record

To continue you'll need to upload your exitentry record issued by the National Immigration Administration (NIA).

Your exit-entry record PDF can be downloaded from the NIA mini programme through WeChat, Alipay or the NIA app.

What you'll need to do:

- Ensure the name on your document exactly matches the name provided on this application
- . Upload only 1 file in pdf format
- Ensure you'reuploading your latest exit-entry record, that should be the same date as your account application date.
